Your RCM team attended July region. There are 2 motions to vote on and 3 resumes. (Attached to this report) Please remember to bring your group's vote back to the October ASC.

Motion 071325-01: To add to a position to the Regional Executive Board that should be named "Regional IT Facilitator" which will need to be adopted into current guidelines as an odd year nomination and election with a two-year service commitment. This will also create an additional future budget line to accommodate needs for position as other board positions. All motions in guidelines that reference said changes will be updated as such.

Intent: To assist Region with consistent needs that arise in regards to IT issues, Website update turn around times, ZOOM, and meeting set ups.

Motion 071325-02: To update the guidelines, section 6.5.a to add SMRCNA Chair into the audit rotation.

Intent: Is the spirit of rotation for all sub committee chairs to rotate through the quarterly audit rotation.

Motion 071325-03: Was killed on the floor. (Do not need group votes on this motion)

The positions that needed voted on are as follows: Regional Treasurer, Regional Alt. Treasurer, and IT Chair. There is only 1 resume per position.
